WHAT

The goal of Faithful Witness is to share the gospel with people who have never heard of Jesus Christ. We seek to place teams of workers in communities across the world where there is no church and virtually no Christian witness.

Teams are multi-cultural, multi-ethnic, and multi-skilled and led by an experienced worker. We are intentionally spreading our financial assistance to ensure each team is made up of people from different countries, cultures and ethnic backgrounds.

HOW

The teams will live in community, building relationships, and learning language. We have developed a new funding model to enable workers from all over the world to join Faithful Witness teams.

The programme offers matched funding for any worker who wishes to join a Faithful Witness team. The funding will be offered for up to five years, at the end of which the worker is expected to be fully self-supported.

WHERE

We are now working in eight locations: Mali, Chad, Nigeria, East Africa, North Africa, the Middle East, Central Asia, and Thailand. Currently, none of these communities have any significant Christian witness. They were chosen because we have good local support networks and are confident we can place teams in these communities. TEAMS



CHAD

We partner with like minded organizations in eastern Chad to place workers among people who have no church in their mother tongue.



MALI

The Hassaniya people are open to receiving workers who will live among them and learn the language and culture. There are only four known believers.



NIGERIA

There are an estimated 20 million Fulani in Nigeria. Today there is an open door for ministry among this least-reached, nomadic community.



N. AFRICA

The team is equipping subsaharan college students in North Africa to effectively reach their Muslim classmates with the gospel.



E. AFRICA

Through partnerships local universities, workers use their professional training to connect with this forgotten community.



MIDDLE EAST

The team engages this community through vocational and speech therapy, serving families with special needs children.



THAILAND

Ayutthaya is 70 kms north of Bangkok. The team is focused on sports ministry, church planting, and English and Chinese language ministries in this city.



CENTRAL ASIA

This team engages the local community by providing vocational skills and language training as a means to establish relationships and share Christ's love.
