



PRAYING FOR COMMUNITIES WHERE CHRIST IS LEAST KNOWN

EAST AFRICA

We appreciate your prayers. The Lord is at work. We are seeing more people openly following Jesus, the way, truth and life. Recently a worker had opportunity to share the gospel with a young man who had arrived in our locality and was wandering the streets looking lost and confused. As the worker took the man into his home, fed him, and gave him a bed to sleep in he also opened up the word of God. When asked, “Do you believe?”, he said yes, gave his life to Christ and, since then, has been baptised.

MALI

Pray for peace in Mali. The security situation has deteriorated further with widespread terrorist attacks. Pray for the churches and for local friends, asking God’s intervention and protection.

Pray for workers in transition—one has begun a new assignment in a West-African nation, another has just entered a least-reached nation in Asia, others are seeking God’s next thing for them.

MIDDLE EAST

Give thanks for a fragile ceasefire and the tentative change in economic situations in the city. The effects of war are ongoing even as people hope for more stability in the region. Pray especially concerning the influence of underground groups of militia. Ask God to work in the hearts of government officials to reopen short-term visas, allowing workers to return.

Praise God for believers loving Jesus with their whole heart, mind, soul and strength. May they increasingly love their neighbours, answering their questions and sharing about God who brings revelation and renewal. Pray for families of children with special needs to persevere, to seek God and trust his love, and see his answers for their children.

CENTRAL ASIA

Ask for good health, mental strength and protection for workers and their families. May God go ahead, preparing hearts, as discipleship and training classes take place. Pray leaders and students will stay safe—ask for growth in knowledge, love, and fruitfulness.

SOUTH ASIA

As far as the eye can see, this land is unreached and filled with idol worship. Pray people will know the light of truth and be filled with the hope of eternal life. Pray new workers will be added to the team. Pray for smooth visa renewal and registration processes and continued open doors. Ask godly wisdom and discernment as new ministries are considered.

Give thanks for recent answers to prayer for the missional business. Many people are in the interview process—may they be successfully hired. As we expand our network and company we are in the process of hiring another employee and a freelancer, ask God’s leading and provision.

AYUTTHAYA, THAILAND

Pray for Thai Buddhists, a large people group strongly connected to religious traditions and to animism. There are very few Christians. Many regions are unreached by the good news of Jesus. There are also opportunities to reach refugees from Myanmar, Laos and China. Pray believers interact with people and know how best to point to God with their lives, words, and deeds. Give praise for the impact of ministry within Thai Buddhist schools. Though we have wide open doors we need wisdom. We are considering leaving one of the schools as our capacity is limited, and we are wondering if we may be needed more in other places.

Ask spiritual and physical health during hot season. May we serve with strength, faithfully. As a new team member arrives next month ask provision of accommodation and good transitions.

NORTH AFRICA

As national and international opportunities arise, workers intentionally share their testimony and promote the call to believers to actively share the good news. Pray, as workers visit Brazil mid-May to speak about the great needs of both North Africa and Central Asia. May this mobilise workers for a great harvest. Give praise for the workers God has sent to this difficult field as 'light of the world', so that the unbelievers might see 'the glory of the Lord and the splendour of our God' in the face of Christ! The many years of their hard work is yielding the fruit of spiritual formation within local believers and international students. May God strengthen and encourage workers, resourcing them with prayer and financial supporters, allowing them to focus fully on the work to which they are called. Pray for a family's plans, preparations and adjustments as they return from Home Assignment.

NORTHERN NIGERIA

Pray the small 'under the tree' schools for Fulani children become well established, successfully providing education and bringing God's light and peace into communities. Ask for rain and grass/feed for Fulani herds, the region is suffering.

Give thanks for churches and individuals that pray and support the work of Fulani ministry. Pray for continued protection, and open doors to reach many people and whole communities with good news that transforms lives. May Christians sow in peace and reap a harvest of righteousness.

Ask provision of the resources of workers and finances to allow workers, their families, and ministry to thrive. Keep praying for favour with immigration and the change of processes and fees to allow new workers to get visas.

EASTERN CHAD

Pray the Lord blesses people within Chad, may he be gracious to them, bless them, and give them peace. May words of truth fall on good soil, bearing fruit. Pray God leads others to join in his work here.

Pray concerning the ongoing ban on visas for US workers. May possible exemptions allow previous workers to swiftly return to Chad. Ask God's sustaining grace for remaining workers—one family has returned from Home Assignment and is to move to another town to cover ministry needs. One family is asking prayer for the housing and schooling needs of their children who will remain in West Africa as their parents return to Chad. Another family has returned to Ethiopia for Home Assignment and asks prayer regarding re-connections with family and churches, and for safe travels. May workers experience God's guidance, strength, wisdom, and protection.
